

DECLARATORY STATEMENT 1999-01

The Louisiana Board of Chiropractic Examiners makes the following Declaratory Statement pursuant to its authority under LAC 46:XXVII.507:

It is the opinion of the Board that under LSA R.S. 37:2801(3), which defines the scope of chiropractic, that

“a chiropractor may delegate to a chiropractic assistant the performance of services incidental to the practice of chiropractic provided that the delegation is consistent with the standards of acceptable chiropractic practice embraced by the chiropractic community in which the doctor practices. However, only those chiropractic assistants certified by the Board in accordance with the provisions of LSA R.S. 37:2828 shall be involved in the taking of x-rays.”
