

DECLARATORY STATEMENT 2017-01

The Louisiana Board of Chiropractic Examiners makes the following Declaratory Statement pursuant to its authority under LAC 46:XXVII.507:

It is the opinion of the Board that under LAC46:XXVII.321, which defines “Dry Needling”, that

“the required 50 (fifty) hours shall not be duplicative and should be consecutive course hours which build on the previous hours for increased knowledge and understanding. Further, “Dry Needling” should not be practiced outside of a supervised classroom until successful completion of the 50 (fifty) hours are obtained.”

Adopted this 14th day of December, 2017, by the Louisiana Board of Chiropractic Examiners.
